SUBJECT: City of Del Rey Oaks Stormwater Permit Requirement – Mapping Requirement

MEETING DATE: October 27, 2015

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive a presentation by California State University-Monterey Bay (CSU-MB) ENV660 Class on their recent work on behalf of the City of Del Rey Oaks to assist in the completion of stormwater mapping requirements required under the Phase II MS4 Stormwater Permit.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Del Rey Oaks operates and maintains a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) regulated by the State Water Resources Control Board's Phase II MS4 Stormwater Permit (Stormwater Permit). A requirement for Year 2 of the Stormwater Permit included an outfall mapping exercise. The intent of the mapping exercise is to assist the City of Del Rey Oaks with the prioritization of land use areas for the continued protection of water quality.

Students from CSU-MB ENV660 Class completed this permit requirement on behalf of the City of Del Rey Oaks and are available to present their work to Council Members.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Del Rey Oaks participates in a regional collaboration to assist with compliance activities under its Stormwater Permit. The Monterey Regional Stormwater Management Program (MRSWMP) consists of seven entities including the Cities of Carmel-by-the-Sea, Del Rey Oaks, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Sand City, Seaside, and the County of Monterey.

To ensure the successful completion of Year 2 Stormwater Permit mapping requirements in a cost effective manner, City of Del Rey Oaks Staff and MRSWMP partnered with AMBAG and CSU-MB ENV Class 660.

City Manager Dawson: Pulled C.1.

City Manager Dawson: Asked to move consent item c1 to 7c new business No objections

Council Member Allion: Wants to give the City Manager a chance to explain the cash balance of \$65,000.

City Manager Dawson: Balance is \$100,000 as of today and as known this is a snapshot in time. Our income is cyclical and doesn't match our expenses and November is a cash short month normally.

Old Business:

The Council considered **ITEM 6.A.** Consider Ordinance 282, an Ordinance of the City of Del Rey Oaks Adding Chapter 15.50 to the Del Rey Oaks Municipal Code to provide an expedited, streamlined, permitting process for Small Residential Rooftop Solar Systems. (*Second Reading*)

City Manager Dawson: This is the second reading of the solar ordinance. There have been no changes from last month.

New Business:

The Council considered **ITEM 7.A.** Consider Covenant Agreement between the City of Del Rey Oaks and 21 Quendale Avenue to allow a fence to be placed on the City's Easement.

City Manager Dawson: Stated the homeowner place some pillars and a gate along his property preparing for a fence and we issued a stop work and notified homeowner he needed a covenant agreement because it encroached onto the City's easement.

Council Member Ventimiglia: Has this gone through Planning Commission?

Deputy City Clerk Carvalho: No, it must be approved by the council and then to Planning Commission for design review

Council Member Allion: This was built prior to approval?

City Manager Dawson: Yes

Mayor Edelen: Explained the covenant agreement and what it does to protect the city for any future development like sidewalks, underground electrical, etc.

Council Member Ventimiglia: How does this much get built before they come before the council?

Milos Pesic, Homeowner: Moved here 11 years ago and people would walk their dogs, drive across their property. It took time to save the money for the fence. He didn't know he had to get a permit.

Council Member Ventimiglia: Will this interfere with the utility right of way for utility pole?

City Manager Dawson: No, he is taking the fence behind the pole and it is 2 ½ feet away on either side.

Motion to approve: Council Member Ventimiglia

Second: Council Member Lintell

Public Comment: None

Motion passed: 4-0

The Council considered ITEM 7.B., Consider solutions for speeding cars on Portola Drive and Carlton Drive.

Mayor Edelen: Stated the Council Member Lintell and several residents came to him and asked that this be put on the agenda for open discussion.

Public Comment:

Dr. Caplan-Dowe, Carlton: Have kids, they want them to be able to ride bikes in the street. Cars flying down the hill to 218. Wants speed bumps. Talked about leaving Del Rey Oaks because of it. Wants a safe place.

Mayor Edelen: Asked for show of hands for who wanted speak.

Nicole Beulich, Portola: Loves the community and speeding in front of their home is a problem. Can't imagine a time when they (kids) can be in the front yard because of the traffic issue. Have to take kids to a park.

Alexis (inaudible), Portola: 2013 moved here. Seems like everyone here has a value for community. They know many people in the room just walking their neighborhood. Concerned about speeding on Portola and Carlton. Sees residents speeding multiple times per week. Wants a permanent solution.

Karen (inaudible). 54 year resident. There was quite a period of time where there were no children. There are no sidewalks so you have to walk in the street. Some solution would be great.

Nick Wooler, Carlton Dr.: Nice to see children in town. Lived here for 14 year. Serious problem. 10 years ago he talked to the council about the same problem. PD put out police cars, radar station and it had temporary impact. It's not gotten any better in the past 10 years. Wants to see speed cushions like on Plumas. They are temporary so if sidewalks come later they are removable. The issues are known. Do something immediately!

Janelle Ansbury, Work Ave.: 64 year resident. Made complaints previously. Work Ave also needs speed bumps. Kids can't play in the street. Quendale is also a problem. Speed bumps are what we need to protect, children, pets and adults.

(Inaudible): Car accidents are the number killer of kids in America.

Terry Seeders, Carlton: Thinks speed bumps are a great idea as an immediate solution. There are 2 times a day when this happens when everyone goes to work and when they come home.

George Jaksha, Rosita: Has lived here since 1955 wants to know if they are speeding and how many? Tickets should go to speeders. Tell your neighbors to slow down. Speeding from church to stop sign. Paloma has some speeding. Suggests once a month arbitrarily pick a street and give tickets. If speed bumps are put in, not too high.

Lane Buckley, Carlton: Had his car hit 3 times in front of his house. Saw someone speeding and almost hit someone, took a picture and was confronted by the driver. The speeding is a problem but the city isn't doing anything about it. Speed cushions in Seaside are working. Seaside is ahead of Del Rey Oaks. Speed limit increases from 20 to 25 from Seaside into DRO from Highland to Carlton. Traffic cushions and lower speed are the solution. Bicycle lane between Plumas and Canyon Del Rey would also help. Road is wide enough. Cushions are easy to install.

Mike O'Brian, Work Ave: There are speeders on Work Ave. On Carlton and work stop sign is blown all the time. From Saucito people cut through the one way part of the road.

Scott Donaldson, Portola: Speed bumps provide a low cost solution. Recommends a pilot program by installing one speed bump on each side and get feedback before doing all the streets. On Portola natural place is by walkway to Work for a location.

Antonella Randazzo, Portola: Wants a speed bump down by her house in the 800 block of Portola.

Harry Creeger, Portola at Quendale split: Speed bumps are a good solution. Feels tickets are a better solution. Has only seen 2 stops for speeding in his neighborhood. Fastest way to fix speeders is to write tickets.

Danielle Quoboso, Portola: Works from home. Why hasn't anyone done anything about speeders? Loves Del Rey Oaks and neighbors. Top of the hill they gun it to get up the hill. We have lots of walkers and runners, and cars speed down the middle of the road. Agrees police presence is important.

Ray Sampaolo, Saucito: Drainage ditches do stop speeders by his house. They had big back yard and would not allow his kids in the front yard. Speed bumps are the solution and will keep speeders off our city streets.

Bill Ragsdale Cronin, Carlton: Thank the City for the stop sign at Carlton but stated they aren't working any longer. We get lots of speeders. Keep them out of our city. Speed bumps may not be the answer, need to look into other speed calming options like roundabouts.

Ed Culvert, Rosita: Walks every night. Feels police should do what everyone is telling them to do. There is a process and it needs to be put into place. Parents have to take some responsibility too.

Megan Fitzsimmons, Portola: Shared photo of her as a child. Neighborhoods have changed. Most people are happy and proud to be living here. Whatever the solution is the

city has a responsibility to the residents. How do we know they are speeding? Some have downloaded radar apps and they have the data now showing they are.

Katlyn Basic, Carlton: Lived here 11 years. Stated she wants a list of what the city will be doing by next week. By next month they want a plan of what the city will do. Realizes not all council members live on their side and offer the council to park on their street and see the speeding. Quoted the mission statement. Asked the council to hold to that statement. People will help in any way they can. Look forward to a timely resolution.

Milos Pesic, Quendale: About 7 months ago their cat was killed by a neighbor who was speeding. Willing to participate with \$1000 dollars.

Mike Hayworth, Carlton: 50% of the people stop at the sign on Carlton. Problem on Carlton is parked cars and narrowing the street.

Francis Davila, Portola: In 30 minutes she counted 26 cars. Portola is a thoroughfare. Doesn't walk on Portola any longer. There are a lot of cars parked on both sides of the street at the curve. No u-turn sign just makes them go up the street and make a u-turn in home driveways.

Dr. Romero Reyes, Carlton: Exited to see the community organizing.

George Jaksha, Rosita: Had suggested putting barriers on Portola to make it a cul-de-sac.

Mayor Edelen: Feel with everyone that showed up there is a need for speed control. Wants the City Manager and Chief to do a study to see what measures can be done.

Council Member Ventimiglia: This is not a new issue. In 1980 this issue came to them before the council when he was on the council back then. Speed bumps will work but how many and how far between. Likes the idea of technology. Likes the idea ticketing. If you look at the reports they are busy. Likes the idea of cameras taking pictures of speeders and ticketing. Wants to come up with a solution that is good and safe. Here since 1969. The whole city has changed and was not designed for the amount of cars we have. Does feel they need to do something just not sure what. Close off Carlton like they did with Tweed? There are solution but some are radical and there are variables. It can be resolved.

Council Member Allion: Thanked everyone for suggestions and concerns and especially for the offer of a donation. Brings up a lot of questions, including morality. You can not have enough police officers for all the laws without a moral basis. People should be able to say, I don't speed because the speed limit is 25. They don't pay attention. Speed signs may be affective but they don't work for everyone. Impede traffic flow is the solution. Changing the speed limit may help but won't help the speeder. Need some quick information and quick action. Police officer's present during speeding times on Portola and Carlton. The state controls the highway speed. Crossing 218 is dangerous. Flashing signs and crosswalks? State responsibility on 218.

Council Member Lintell: Thanked everyone for coming. Lives on Rosita. From Canyon Del Rey down the hill on Rosita people speed. There is a need to address it city wide not just on the north side. Speed bumps throughout the city.

Council Member Allion: Some kids driving too fast on Via Verde hit the berm in the median and scared them. People have to take action. Confront speeders!

Mayor Edelen: Will report back next month on a plan. In the meantime will work on immediate solutions. We have a limited budget and our City Manager has looked into buying 218 so we would have more control of that road. It would be very expensive and will be contingent on future development income.

Council Member Allion: Asked the audience, how much do you think comes back to the city in property taxes?

Audience member: About 1%

Council Member Allion: 6 cents on the dollar. We struggle with revenue. 65% of money is for police salaries and the rest doesn't go very far.

Audience member: Recommended a public private partnership.

The Council considered **ITEM 3.C.** moved to new business from consent agenda: Agreement for Public Works Maintenance Services

City Manager Dawson: Our only maintenance person retired but he agreed to stay on part time as a contract employee because he is our only maintenance person. As a condition with CalPERS, once someone retires they can't come back and work for the city until 180 days after retirement. CalPERS has an exemption that states if it is a critical position the council can approve an immediate return. He is asking the Council to approve the new contract.

Council Member Ventimiglia: Difference between contract employee and regular employee.

City Manager Dawson: This is to ask them to approve a wave of this 180 days because we need his services! No benefits, no vacation, no sick leave and \$25 an hour.

Council Member Allion: Agrees and glad this agreement can be broken when wanted. What is the plan?

City Manager Dawson: Plan is while he's working he can train a replacement.

Council Member Lintell: Have you looked at a company to replace him rather than an employee?

City Manager Dawson: Will report on that during budget. Glad he agreed to stay to help us out. It was a sudden shock to all of us. Recommending to keep him on.

Public Comment:

Beth Benoit, Portola: If you reduce Joe's hours who will be picking up the trash on 218 behind Safeway?

City Manager Dawson: The chief has talked to the manager of Safeway and we are taking care of it.

Motion to approve: Council Member Ventimiglia:

Second: Council Member Allion

Public Comment: No further received

Motion passed: 4-0

STAFF REPORTS:

City Manager Dawson: Attended FORA, BRAC, regional urban design guidelines meeting. TAC for Water Management District. Mike Rachel our building inspector pushed for a regulation to give an incentive for pressure reducing valve rebates because a lot of homes have excessive pressure which wastes water and wears out plumbing. It was approved by the Water Management District. Garden center is doing well. Met with FORA and developers about South Boundary Road improvements. Attended risk management conference in Tahoe, he is the chair of MBASIA. Talked to PGE about undergrounding utilities. Chamber leadership luncheon will be on Thursday at noon with a speech by the Mayor at the end.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL REPORTS:

Council Member Allion: October meeting will be out of town so not be at that meeting. Water Reclamation agreement is almost done. May have water purification facility by 2019.

Council Member Lintell: Seaside Sanitation meeting attended. Very short. Highlight of the meeting was the BAT truck. She is the alternate to Kristin (Vice Mayor Clark) for MST and attended for her where they approved an incentive for 55 employees for outstanding work. Approved Carl (Sydorek, CEO) to look at land in South County.

Council Member Ventimiglia: Attended AMBAG and Community Human Services. AMBAG was in Corolitos and talked about traffic studies. Renewed the CEO's contract. She has turned that agency around. Community Human Services they talked about homeless youth. Talking about converting some housing for that. Will redo the old house on Pearl for homeless youth. Women's Tea is coming up which is their fundraiser.

Mayor Edelen: TAMC meeting is tomorrow about the proposed toll road on 156. Also the 3/8th cent sales tax on the ballot. It is important to pass this to become a self help county. Annual city picnic was a huge success. David Kimball is the chairman (DROCAG) and is great! Pat Lintell is on it too but was unable to attend because she was out of town. The MRAP was great, book mobile was there. Dan Dawson had flames 60 feet from his house and came to the picnic anyway, dedicated. Spoke at the ceremony for Eleanor Fitzsimmons. Kudos to DROPD for helping with the Sand City shooting. Special thanks to Council Member Ventimiglia for his tireless work on the dog park. Thursday at noon will be speaking at the chamber luncheon at the Hyatt. Announced the Meet Your City Staff for November 21, 2015 at 2 pm.

The mode speed for this traffic study was 25MPH and the 85th percentile was 32.74 MPH.


Dear Chief Langford,
