The City of Del Rey Oaks plans to conduct pavement maintenance in the next two weeks. As part of this process, the City's contractor, Bond Blacktop, Inc. will apply a slurry seal surface treatment on the streets listed below:

How Will I Be Affected? Prior to work taking place on your street, "No Parking" signs will be placed on the street stating the day, date, and time of the parking restrictions. To avoid towing of your vehicle, please park in your driveway or move your vehicle to a location outside of the "No Parking Zone" prior to 8:00 AM. During the work, your street will be temporarily closed and you will not be able to enter or exit your driveway for 4-6 hours or until the slurry seal has completely dried. All streets will be reopened by 5:00PM.

Slurry seal is applied wet, so please do not attempt to move barricades or drive on the surface until the slurry has completely dried and the road has been reopened as this will damage the street surface and your vehicle. The wet slurry seal will stick to your tires and paint and is very difficult to completely remove. If you need to use your vehicle the day the work is scheduled, please park on an adjacent street not posted with "No Parking" signs.
